Why Gloucester?

- Gloucester (population 122,000) is an historic city on the River Severn, 147 kms from west of London. It has a magnificent cathedral, many lovely old buildings and historic docks with excellent shops. Nearby are the scenic Cotswold Hills.
- ✓ Gloucester is not overcrowded with overseas students and offers a typically British environment in which to study.
